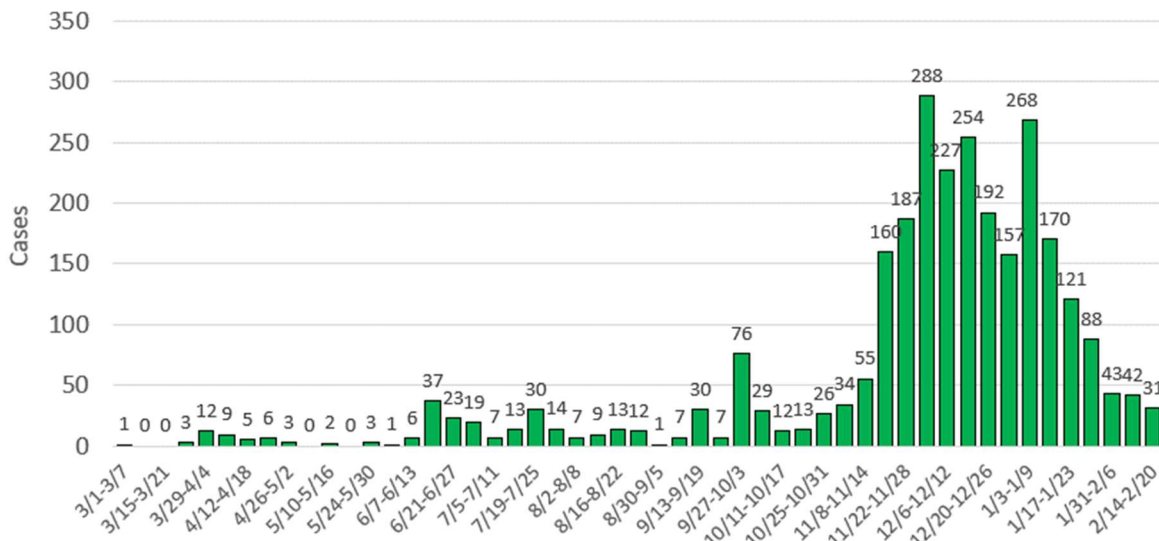

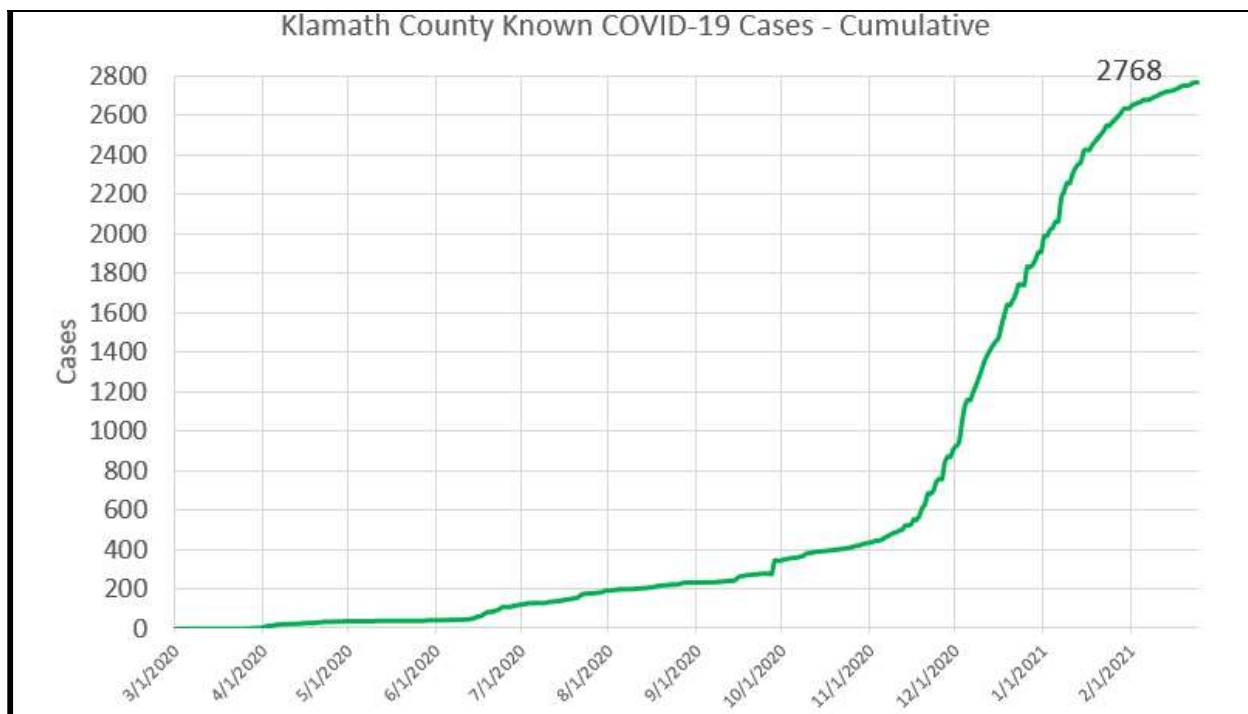

Klamath County Known COVID-19 Cases by Week



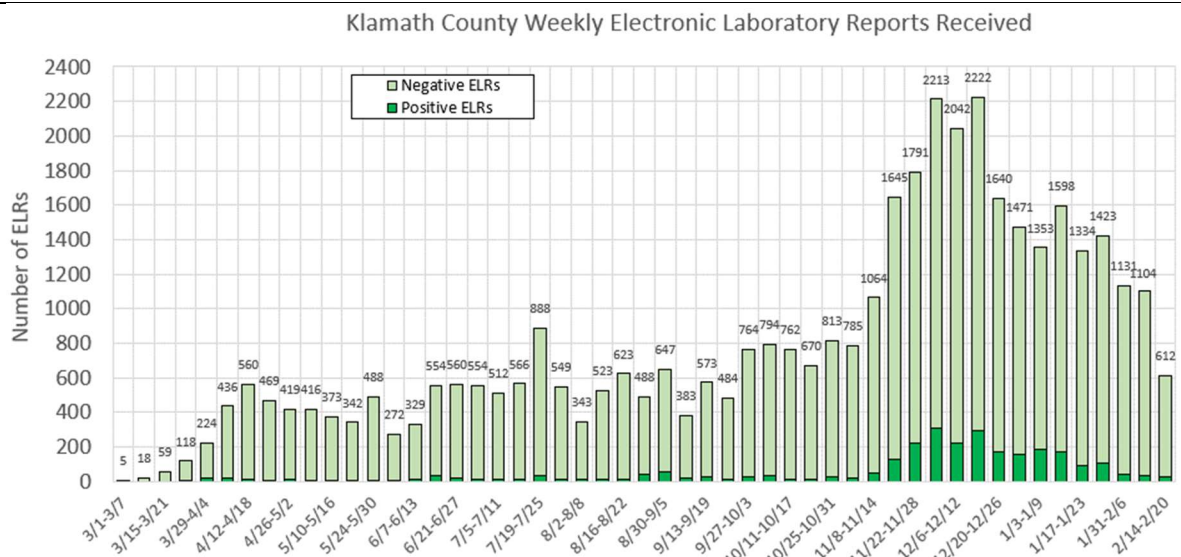

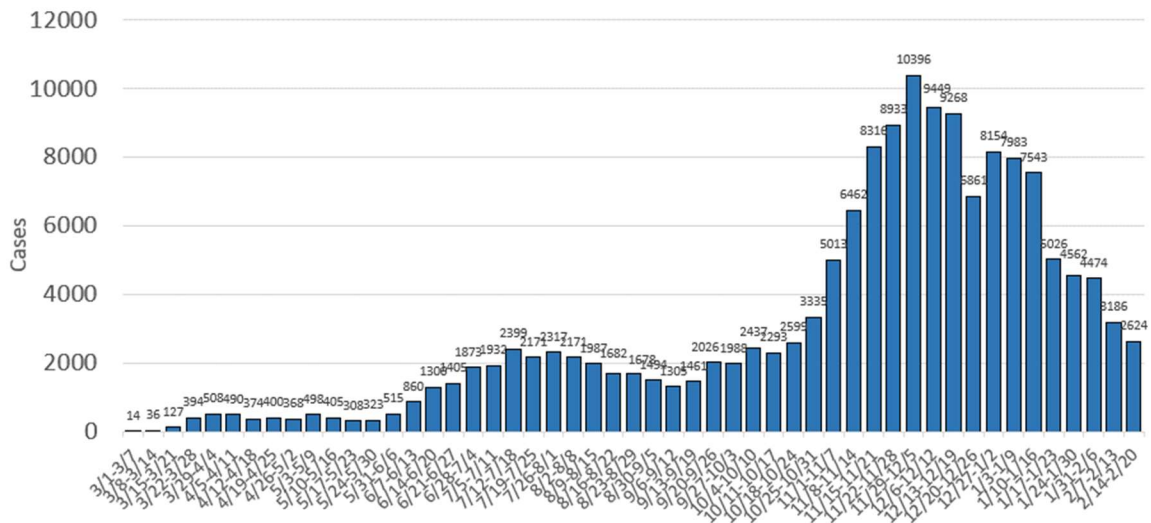

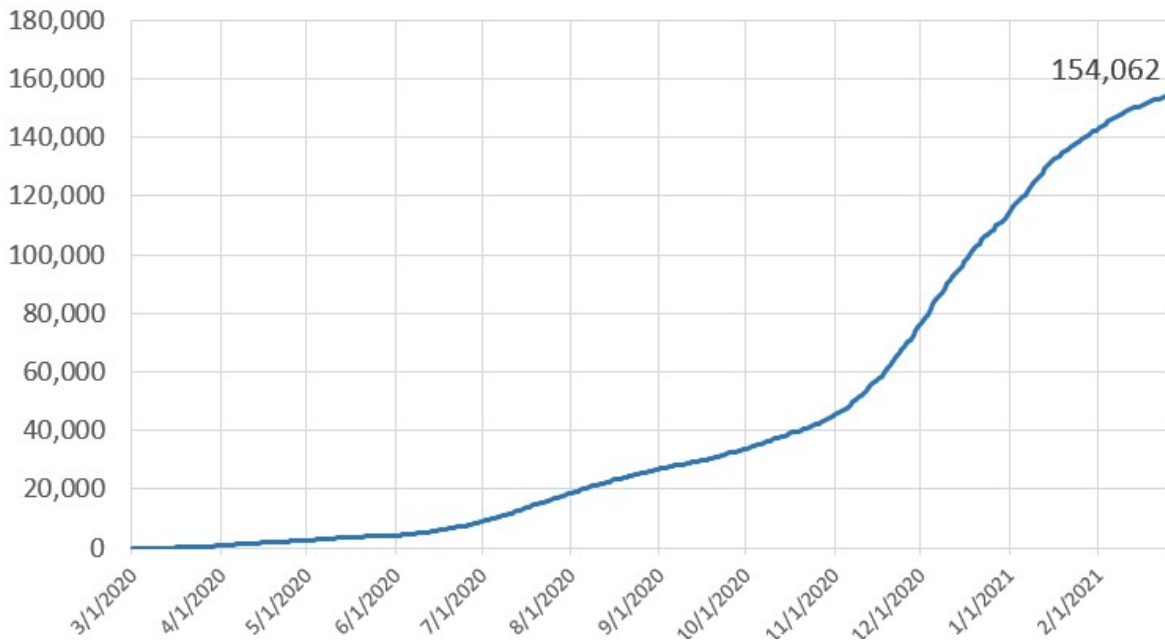

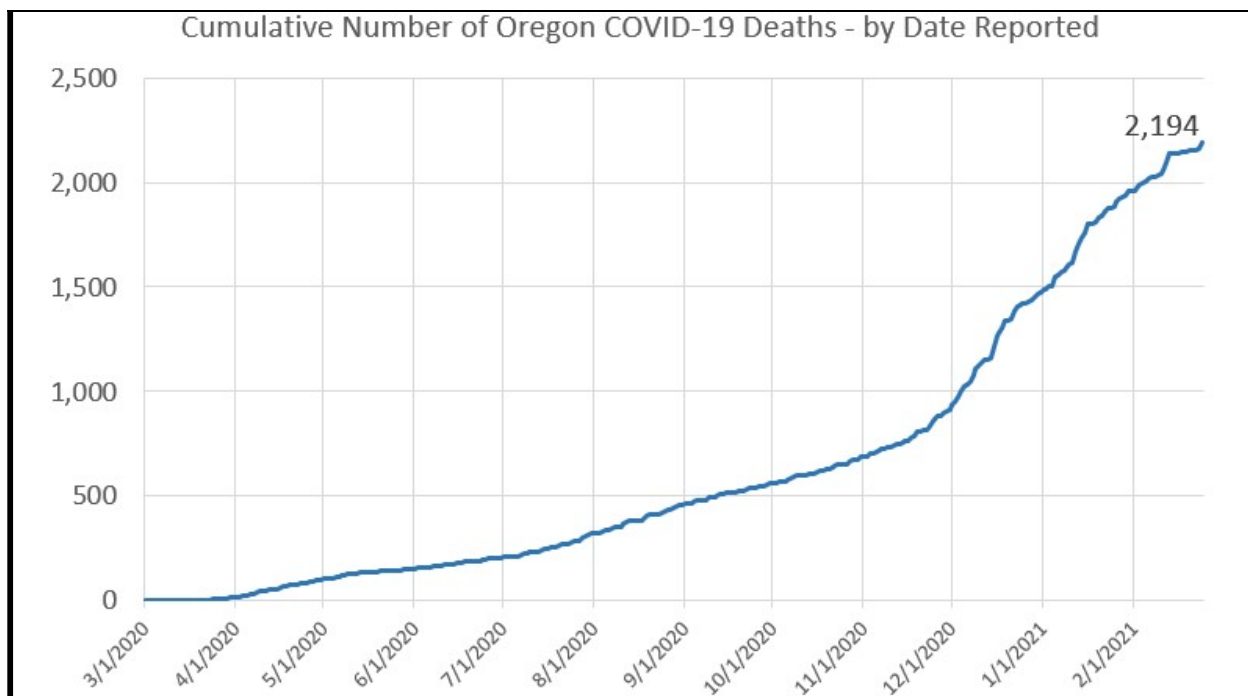
Oregon Known COVID-19 Cases - By Calendar Week

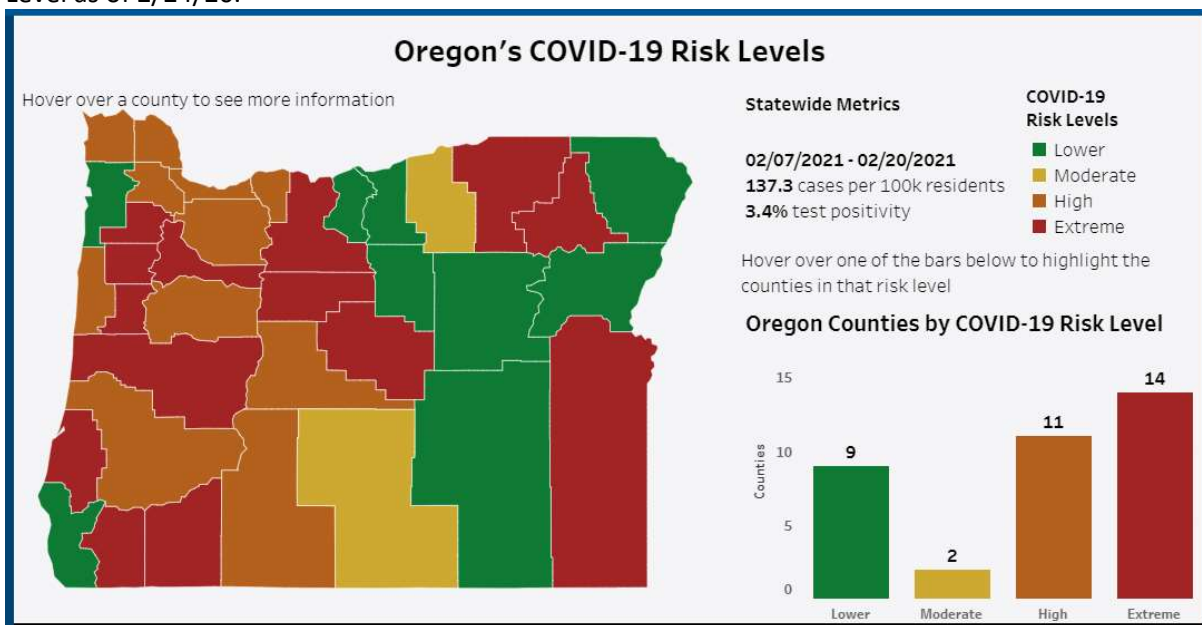
Cumulative Number of Known Oregon COVID-19 Cases - by Date Reported





### COVID-19 Risk Levels Summary

Oregon Health Authority's new [COVID-19 Risk Level framework](#) was implemented on 12/3/2020. This framework uses the same indicators as the school metrics above to classify counties into Risk Levels based on current spread of COVID-19. Most counties in Oregon, including Crook County, are currently classified as "extreme" risk due to widespread COVID-19. The map below shows the current Risk Level as of 2/24/20.



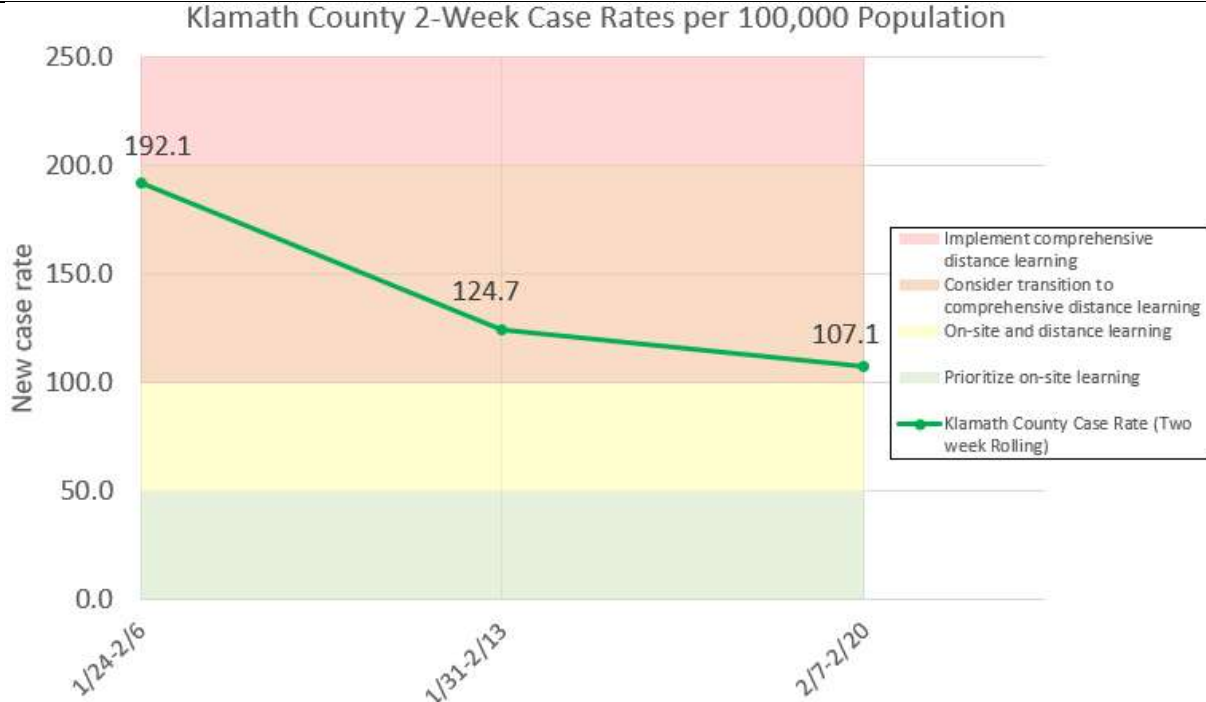
Klamath County is currently in the High Risk Level based on data from 1/24 to 2/6.

**Movement Week Information:** On February 26<sup>th</sup>, Klamath County will be in the High Risk Level based on data from 2/7 to 2/20.

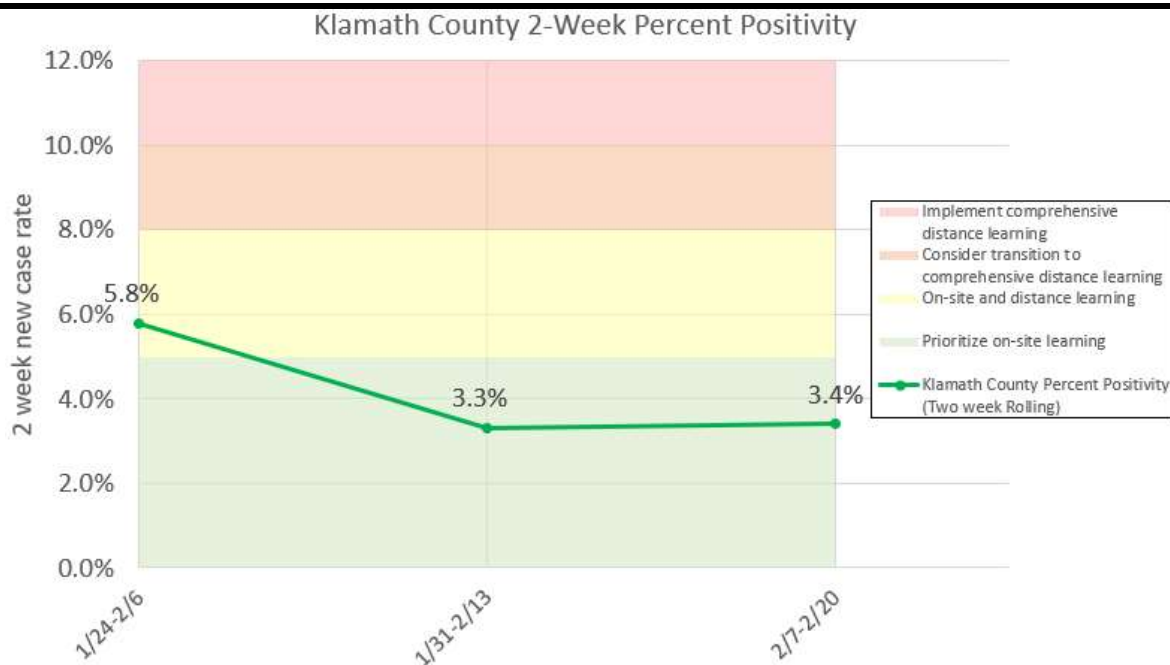

## Ready Schools, Safe Learners: Community COVID-19 Metrics

Klamath County is classified as a “small county” (<30,000 residents), which means that school reopening decisions are based on a 2-week county case count and a 2-week county test percent positivity.



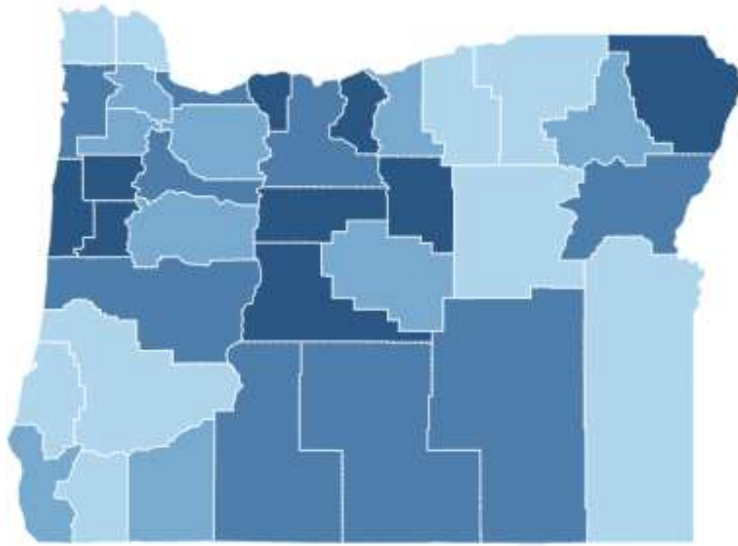
