# LECTIONARY PREVIEW STUDY

For June 6, 2021

## Genesis 3:8–15

1. Read Genesis 2:24-25. Now, what changed in Adam's thinking in 3:10? Why did Adam experience shame: his nakedness or his guilt?
2. Eve says in v. 13 the serpent deceived her. How would you describe the deception, that is, what was Satan seeking to accomplish (Gen. 3:4)?
3. The curse God pronounces in vv.14-15 is directed at the serpent, but then the language moves to the descendants of the serpent and the woman. Despite the crushing and tragic entrance of sin into humanity, there is hope in v. 15? What will the offspring of the woman do to Satan? To which descendent of Eve is this pointing?
4. If you execute an Internet search for "Genesis 3:15 technical term" what result is generated?  
\_\_\_\_ \_ (15 letters!) What does this word mean?

## 2 Corinthians 4:13–5:1

5. St. Paul describes the Christian view as "looking to things unseen." For comparison, how does the writer of Hebrews describe this, in 11:1?
6. In v.16, St. Paul writes, "our outer self is wasting away." What is Paul teaching here? Have a gander at either 1 Corinthians 15:21, 22 or Romans 5:12-21.
7. How are Christians being renewed inwardly? 1 Corinthians 15:42-55.

## Mark 3:20–35

8. The scribes who witnessed Jesus' miracles could not deny their reality, and rather believe the miracles were from God, they attributed them to whom?
9. Is Satan the same as Beelzebub? Look at 1 Kings 1:2.
10. Now look at Job 1:12 and 1 Peter 3:18-19? The devil prowls around like a roaring lion, yet how far does his freedom extend?
11. Because the devil is "God's devil," who is Jesus referring to in v. 27?
12. Verse 29 is a strong admonition to us, but who is eternal punishment originally intended for? See Matthew 25:41?
13. St. Mark, on several occasions, 'interrupts' the accounts recorded in his gospel. For example, vv. 20, 21 connect with vv. 31-35, but are interrupted by vv. 22-30. There is a point to this. What contrast is Jesus teaching with what his family is saying in v. 21 compared to vv. 34-35? Do Jesus' words in v. 35 seem stronger after the 'interruption' especially in light of vv. 28, 29?


