Samuel Clay Singleton (Sammy), 48 years old, gained his wings early March 31, 2018 after a long battle with his health. He was born December 14, 1969 to Michael and Christie Singleton. He grew up in Provo, Utah his entire life. Sam graduated Provo High School in 1988 after which he attended the College of Southern Utah, now known as Southern Utah University, for a year before serving an LDS mission in Porto Portugal.
