Administrators can also now complete all user access management directly in Blueprint 11.2.

All existing and new assets created in the legacy Blueprint application can be used in Blueprint 11.2 — making the migration of your users to the new, modern experience effortless.

With Blueprint 11.2, you will have access to a streamlined, intuitive user experience with enhanced functionality, along with the latest innovations and support for additional browsers.
