### Sacrament of Baptism

Registered parishioners who plan to have their baby baptized should notify the parish office at the beginning of the pregnancy and register for Baptism Preparation, which is held monthly. One godparent must be a Catholic in good standing (e.g., married in the Catholic Church, participating in Sunday Mass), at least 16 years of age, registered in the parish where he lives, and fully initiated (received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion). He must obtain a letter of eligibility from his current parish. One practicing non-Catholic Christian may also be admitted as a Christian Witness. The next class will be on **August 10th via Zoom**. Please contact [mhoggard@piusxparish.org](mailto:mhoggard@piusxparish.org), at least one week before the class, for more information and to register.

Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office six months prior to the wedding date. **Wedding times are Saturday at either 10am, 11am or 1pm.**
