

**Notification of Resumption of Operations at DTS Site #2**

In a filing submitted September 27, 2019, the University of North Carolina (“UNC-TV” or the “Licensee”), licensee and permittee of WUNF-TV, Asheville, North Carolina (Fac. ID No. 69300), notified the Commission that one of the two DTS sites licensed/permitted for WUNF-TV’s operations was off the air. *See* LMS File No. [0000082362](#).

More specifically, on or around September 17, 2019, the Licensee discovered that WUNF-TV’s DTS Site #2 (i.e., the site located at 35° 28' 25.3" N 83° 19' 22.5" W NAD 83) was off air as a result of antenna system issues. UNC-TV is pleased to report that, as of October 3, full operations were restored at WUNF-TV’s DTS Site #2, and the facility at Site #2 appears to now be stable.

For clarity, the Licensee observes that at all relevant times since September 11, 2019, WUNF-TV’s DTS Site #1 has been operating on its post-transition channel using interim facilities (specifically, the aux antenna licensed in LMS File No. [0000081299](#)). Neither the silent notification filed on September 27 for Site #2 nor this resumption notification are intended to suggest that there has been any alteration of the operations at WUNF-TV’s DTS Site #1.
