Be thankful when you're tired and weary, because it means you've made a difference.

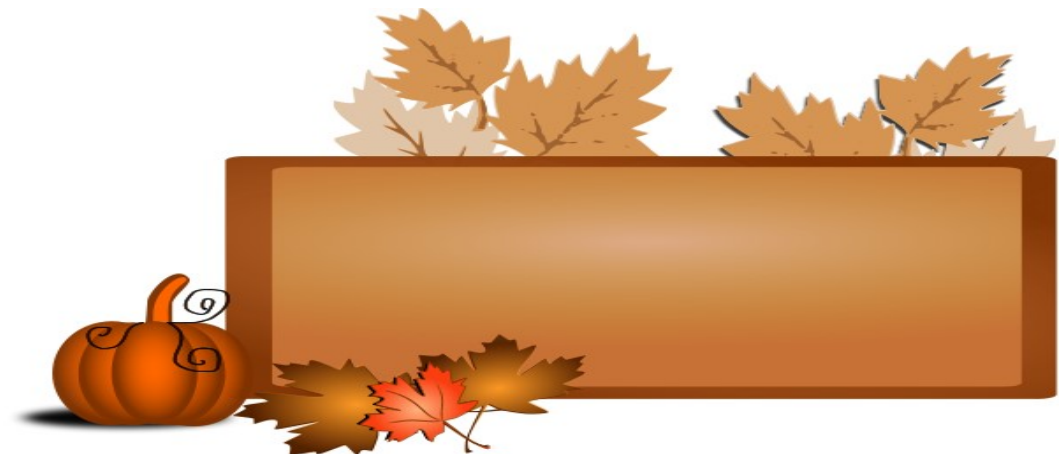
