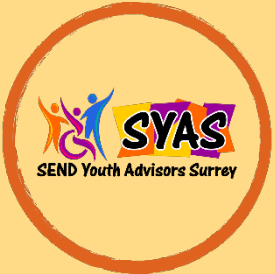

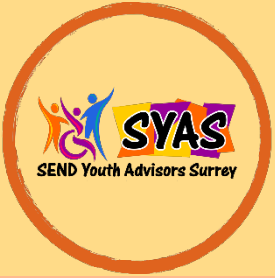

- young people's thoughts on what information professionals should make an effort to find out about them and how they can do this
- Young people's experiences of feeling lost, anxious, worries, frustrated, embarrassed, etc.
- Young people to tell us about a time when they have accessed a service and they have felt scared, anxious, frustrated, embarrassed, disregarded etc. so professionals can understand what it is like for young people accessing services
- Young people to tell us some characteristics of an ideal or nightmare worker. Perhaps their own drawings of this.



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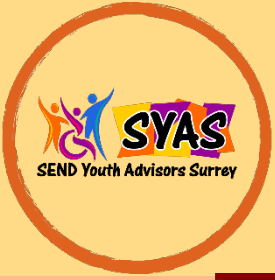

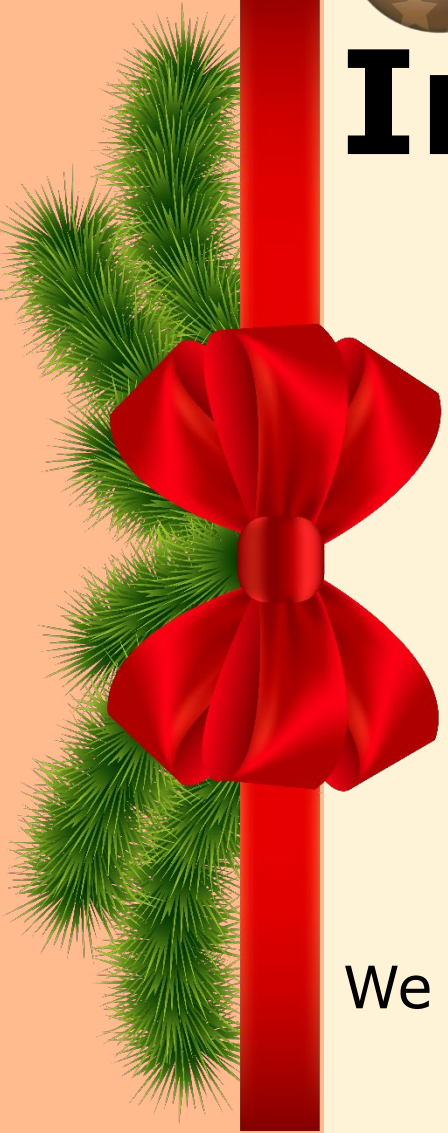

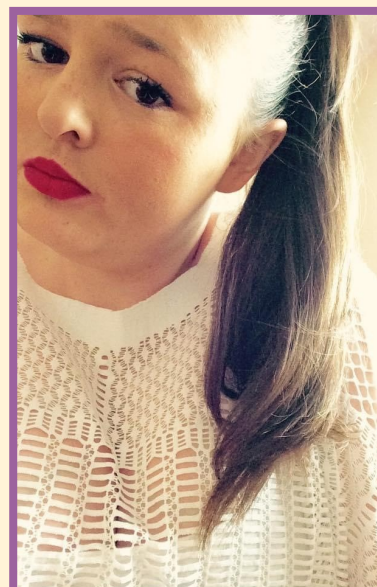
