GRCGLA Members:

Over the past several years the club has offered on our website a Breeder Referral link to a club member, who received clearances of litters from club members who met the requirements. During the past couple of years, very few litters were listed, and this past year none were listed. The referral system was not working for potential puppy buyers or for the referral club volunteers. When someone contacted us, they received education and information on what to look for in a breeder and what health issues and clearances to be checking for, but few litters were being listed.

On page 3 you will see a different approach to provide education and information to new Golden Retriever puppy buyers. This falls in line with several other clubs, including our parent club. I hope this approach helps guide buyers to quality breeders and the much needed educational information about questions to ask and required clearances.

Club members will receive the Code of Ethics via email, and those in good standing who sign and return the COE form to our correspondence secretary will be listed on our website. These members will have agreed to follow the COE and be good stewards for our beloved breed.

Please review all the information we have posted on our site. We recommend spending the time, learn about our breed by checking out the links to other educational and informational sites when researching and acquiring a golden retriever. This information has been prepared to help you purchase a quality puppy from a reputable breeder who has the betterment of the breed as his/her goal in breeding Golden Retrievers.

GRGCLA recommends checking the health clearances on both the sire and the dam, and that their age be 2 years or older at the time of breeding. The clearances include: OFA hips, OFA elbows, OFA Heart from a board-certified Cardiologist, and a current (within 12 months) Eye clearance from a board- certified ophthalmologist.

GRGCLA encourages all breeders to follow the recommended guideline from GRCA regarding the breeding of Golden Retrievers for health and temperament. Please be aware from whom you are buying a puppy. People who run puppy mills know the right thing to say to convince you that it's not important to have the proper clearances, (hip, elbow, heart and eyes) on both parents. Don't be fooled! Insist on seeing the papers or don't buy. A reputable breeder will always give you copies of all the health clearances on both parents. If they don't, walk away.

Breeders Code of Ethics

GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB OF GREATER LOS ANGELES CODE OF ETHICS FOR MEMBERS OF BREEDERS REFERRAL DIRECTORY
All members of the Referral Directory shall agree to the following: All litters (whether owning the stud dog or brood bitch) shall have OFA Clearances including Hip, Elbow, Heart (from veterinary cardiologist), and current Eye clearance (within 12 months from a veterinary ophthalmologist) for both sire and dam. A member of the Referral Directory shall not serve as a broker for any other member or nonmember in the selling of Golden Retriever puppies. A broker is defined as someone who receives compensation in the selling of Golden Retriever puppy for which the individual does not own or co-own the dam. The Referral Directory believes in responsible breeding and at any time, if a puppy or dog sold is no longer wanted by the owner, the breeder agrees to accept back this puppy or dog sold (refund is not necessary). Provide a written contract for all dogs sold. Members of the Golden Retriever Club of Greater Los Angeles are concerned about the current proliferation of inferior quality puppies. As any breed grows in popularity, it is inevitable that poor quality pups will be produced either by misinformed pet owners who breed pet to pet just to have a litter or by profit-seeking individuals who do not give thought to the quality, appearance or temperament of pups they produce. Many people are breeding inferior quality bitches to equally inferior dogs, producing even more inferior pups with hip and eye problems as well as breed disqualifications. This uneducated form of breeding can lead to the destruction of the breed.
