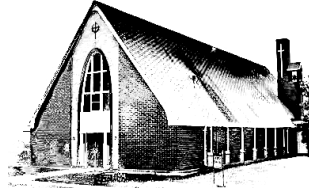

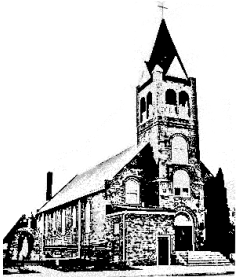

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and St. Mary's,

It was a beautiful Easter, a bright and sunny day. A great day to celebrate the love of God, as Jesus overcame sin and death to rise "early on the first day of the week" (Jn 20:1a) "The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ, a faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross: Christ is risen from the dead, dying, he conquered death; to the dead, he has given life" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 238).

After Easter we look forward to Pentecost, the celebration of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon all those gathered together to await the promise of the Father as Jesus said, "I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high" (Lk 24:49b). We all need "power from on high" to live our life in Christ.

Please note in this weekends bulletin of Bishop Folda's letter reinstating the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligations. Our Blessed Lord takes it personally of our attendance at Mass on Sundays. "No one comes to the Father except through me" (Jn 14:6b).

Decree
Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass
In Nomine Domini. Amen.

Whereas, due to the severity of the Covid-19 pandemic, on March 17, 2020 I dispensed the faithful of the Diocese of Fargo from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation; and

Whereas, circumstances now allow us to attend Mass safely;

Therefore, beginning May 1, 2021, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is reinstated in the Diocese of Fargo.

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe they were recently exposed to Covid-19 or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or a nursing facility; those who care for the sick, the infirm, and the homebound; those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own; those with underlying health conditions or in a high-risk category; and those who have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by attending Mass.

One should consult their pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass.

With the assurance of prayers for the holiness and good health of all, I extend my apostolic blessing to the faithful of the Diocese of Fargo.
